For me, being disabled is a blessing in disguise! As an educator who contributes my service for Indonesian Blind Union (PERTUNI) in Bandung Regency area, a unique teaching approach in special needs education frequently arises in our environment. In this phase, I play a critical role in acquiring the knowledge they need to improve their lives quality.

Currently, PERTUNI continues to confront one major challenge; its members have limited access to digital literacies and educational opportunities; they are unaware that many scholarships are available for blind individuals. So far, their training is restricted only to massage therapy and brooms-handcrafting.

Undoubtedly, this kind of education is outdated and incapable of keeping up with the rapid technological advancements; they need education in a range of more modern spectrums. Sadly, many PERTUNI members are still technologically illiterate and have not mastered smartphones or computers, which means they cannot utilize this skill to live independently or assist their daily activities.

Being the educator who tackles the lack of human resources for PERTUNI, my parents and I established the English Language for Digital Literacy Programme since 2020 on PERTUNI Radio

Station. This program is to assist them in learning how to utilize computers or cellphones that are outfitted with screen reader software and mobile apps specialized for the blind. These programs are JAWS, Be My Eyes, KNFB, Color ID, and LookTel money reader.

During these hardships, my contribution to PERTUNI in technological learning becomes the spearhead; its function is critical. A series of educational programs that my parents and I initiated have been followed by PERTUNI members across the Bandung Regency area. Due to my program, many blind individuals and PERTUNI members now understand how to use and access the technology; they have a higher chance of employment possibilities.

Learning the introducing process of guide dogs for the Indonesian Blind Association at Wyata Guna, homes for the blind. Seeing and believing that guide dogs are far more than excellent in mobility aids provides companionship and enhances confidence and independence for a blind person.

Guide dogs discover how to become not just well-behaved, meticulously socialized dogs but professionals! I follow the two to three months course, learning by doing, by seeing that professional guide dog mobility instructors teach the dogs to guide someone through the complexities of pedestrian travel safely.

In addition to learning how to lead a person safely around obstacles. I realize that guide dogs are also trained in "intelligent disobedience." If they are given an unsafe cue from their handler, they are taught to disobey it (for example: refusing to step into the street when there is oncoming traffic).

Guide dogs are also trained to have impeccable manners (for all those times they visit places of public accommodation, such as restaurants, grocery stores, and public transportation). As a result, they can avoid distractions (such as cats! In addition, all guide dogs possess an eagerness to please and a willingness to work.)

Some of the skills guide dogs learned are; leading a person straight line from point A to B. They stop for all elevation changes, including curbs and stairs, and stopping for overhead obstacles, such as tree limbs and avoiding obstacles in the coming of their path.

He is currently a skilled worker in one of Singapore's leading hospitals; he invented and made his herbal concoction called Brain King Plus for his son, who was suffering from autism at the time, brain vitamins.

I ask whether my audience has an autistic child, epilepsy, or has a speech delay? Have they tried various herbs and medicines from traditional to modern, but nothing has changed?

One of the causes of the emergence of Autism, Epilepsy, Sinusitis is a lack of nutrients that enter the brain. It is estimated that the human brain consists of 100 billion brain cells (neurons) and approximately 1 trillion supporting cells (glia) that help neurons.

Each brain cell is responsible for various body functions and kinetic movements. If the brain does not get enough nutrition, then the brain's work function is also disrupted. However, there has recently been an increase in clinical studies assessing the benefits of autism supplements in children that extend beyond their sleep and digestion.

For example, eye contact, behavior, and depression have recently been noted to have improved in some children with autism who take cod liver oil (rich in vitamins D and A). I presented that children, both with ASD and neurotypical, require a comprehensive diet filled with vitamins and minerals during this time of growth and brain development.
