Twisted Threads by Kaylin McFarren is the final book of a series called "Threads" which contains in total 4 books. It tells the story of Akira Hamada, a geisha who is an assassin for the Zakura-kai (which is a crime syndicate from Japan). She is sent on a mission on a cruise ship to assassinate the murderers of the Zakura-kai's boss's sister who are going to be on that ship. During this excursion she goes through unexpected things and also good moments and bad. Will she prevail in her mission?

This book did particularly good in the area of describing things and different scenarios i.e. "Their bags were taken by one of the crew members, and they were presented glasses of shimmering champagne. The bubbles spiraled up in the flutes and burst as if trying to escape." it had well formulated characters that had a good description of their past, this book good articulation in its righting, the main story and the side stories are very interesting, very good anticipation till the end, and a pretty good love story.

The aspects that I didn't like about this book was the lack of backstory of the secondary characters in my opinion it was a little vague and it is a little confusing if you haven't read the past books, being that it has a lot of information it can be a little hard to keep track a times
