


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### "Newton Glasses Gallery"



This project is an interior design with a change in the use of a 40-year-old building that was working as a bank. The client's request was designing an eyeglasses store. After observing the current situation, the potentials of the building's history and the possibility of its contemporary reproduction, changing the client's proposed plan and turning it into a space as a gallery, were considered. According to the issue raised above, the relationship between indoor and outdoor space was defined as the main goals of the project due to the unity and integration of architectural space with the city, creating social action and new spatial qualities.







"Damien Hirst", a conceptual artist in a project of "The Physical Impossibility of Death in the Mind of the Living Person by suspending the object in space, tries to define the concept of death as a natural matter. According to the principal of nature, the end of any phenomenon gives birth to another phenomenon, as matter never disappears.



Due to this concept and also in order to criticize the occupation of the land by decorative elements, this spacious mass showed itself suspended in the middle of the building. The structure of mass networks and the creation of gaps within it were formed in order to redefine the contemporary boundary between spatial layers as well as to create diverse spatial qualities.





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


### "Boho-Tehran Project"






Floor Plan




# "Yas Lobby Project"

Year: 2019 Location: Tehran, Iran Type: Residential


The objective of this design was to enhance the user experience within the building's lobby, creating a more inviting and functional space. A key consideration was integrating a designated area for the building janitor while simultaneously revitalizing the overall ambiance.

To achieve the client's vision of a bright and welcoming atmosphere, we expanded the windows to maximize natural light, creating a more open and airy feel.

For the final design touch, we introduced an innovative ceiling treatment. While the client initially requested wooden bars for the ceiling and walls, we proposed an alternative solution using drywall, finished with a refined technique that replicates the warmth and texture of wood. This approach maintained the aesthetic appeal while optimizing practicality and durability, ultimately fulfilling the client's design aspirations.




Floor Plan



1. Main entrance


2. Waiting area


The Project is a residential complex located in a 20000 squere meters site in Naft township. The project contains 2 residental towers one of them is 170m height and the other one is 105 m.
