Conceptual Text for a Symbolic Bas-relief

This is a poetic and symbolic interpretation of the raven — seen not as a harbinger of darkness, but as a prophet of silence, memory, and inner strength. Created in 2025 as part of an international showcase, this piece demonstrates my approach to working with archetypes, creating deep symbolic narratives, and building meaningful textual space around visual artworks.



Excerpt from the text:

The raven is the one who carries the night, but does not belong to it. In its shadow, there is not darkness, but memory. Its gaze is not about threat, but about the truth that remains unspoken.

This figure absorbs the essence of indestructibility — a code that survives after a great cleansing. Where others break, it perches on the threshold between light and shadow. And does not bow its head.
