## **English Lesson Plan**

Topic: Days of the Week

Age Group: 7–9 years old

Level: Beginner

Duration: 30–40 minutes

Objectives:

- Students will be able to name the 7 days of the week.
- Students will be able to use simple sentences like "Today is Monday."

Materials Needed:

- PowerPoint slides with day names and pictures
- Printed or digital flashcards
- Short YouTube song: "Days of the Week" (e.g., The Singing Walrus or similar)
- Worksheet (matching days or putting them in order)

Lesson Steps:

1. Warm-Up (5 mins)

Greet the students. Ask simple questions:

- "What day is it today?"
- "Do you go to school on Friday?"

2. Presentation (10 mins)

Show slides or flashcards with each day.

Say the name and ask students to repeat.

Use visuals: school, weekend, sun, books, etc.

- 3. Practice (10 mins)
  - Play a "Days of the Week" song. Sing together.
  - Show scrambled flashcards and ask students to help you put them in order.
- 4. Activity (10 mins)

Students do a worksheet or simple game:

- Match the name to the picture (e.g., "Saturday = park")
- Circle today's day in a calendar
- 5. Review & Goodbye (5 mins)

Quick review:

- "What day comes after Tuesday?"
- "What day is before Friday?"

Thank students and say goodbye.

Assessment:

Observe participation in repetition, game, and worksheet.
