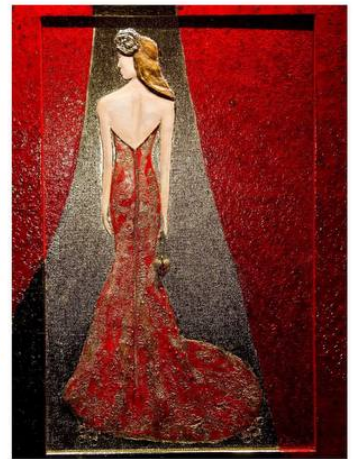
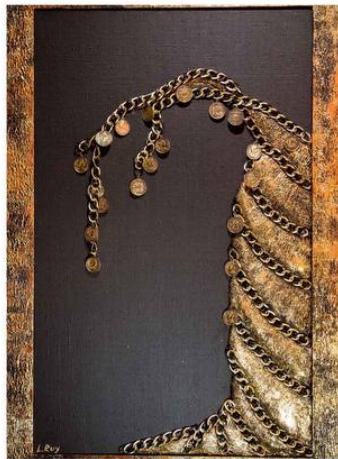
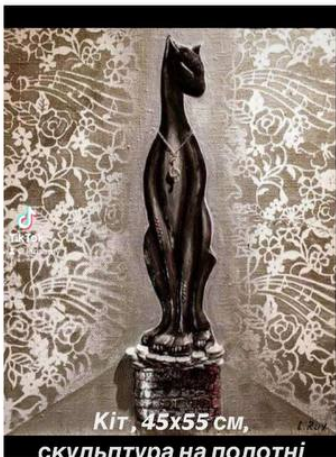


Can a Symbol Change Space?
